To whom it may concern,

As part of our study "*INMA Project: Childhood and Environment*" previously approved by the **CEIC-Parc de Salut Mar**, we are doing a series of air pollution monitoring in **Sabadell**.

Therefore, our technicians will carry various devices that measure different air particles considered influent on the air quality of the city. These devices are completely harmless and, at most, a slight noise might be produced. Also within these devices are filters which are merely samples of exposure and contain particulate matter.

From the **Centre for Research in Environmental Epidemiology (CREAL)** we declare that these devices are not toxic, explosive, oxidative, infectious, radioactive, corrosive or magnetic and that their flash point in closed cup is 40°C. Thus, in accordance with the regulations of IATA and ICAO (Annex 18) on dangerous goods, they present no risk to either land or air transportation.
